

Æèèèòî ïà ñâ. Åñòàòèé Ìèèèää è ñúâðàìáíèòà òãðíëîëèè

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This article presents the results of testing two programs: Compare It!, for simple comparison of files, and Juxta, a specialized program for textual collation. Both are tested for suitability to medieval Slavic texts on a portion from the Vita of St. Eustathius. The results show some basic shortcomings of Juxta. Despite the negative result of the test, it allows the authors to gather enough impressions for creating a list of common desiderata for creating collation software for Slavic texts in the future.

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
